PURPOSE AND FUNCTIONS OF THE COMMITTEE

The Research Ethics and Integrity Committee is chaired by the Vice President of Research and Innovation. The Committee is an independent body with an advisory role on matters of research ethics, compliance, and bioethics.

Specifically, the Committee shall perform the following functions:

- 1. Define the University's research integrity and research ethics policy.
- 2. Establish the University's process and procedures for providing oversight of research integrity and ethical review.
- 3. Provide quality assurance of such procedures.
- 4. Ensure and monitor best practice of research integrity and research ethics across the University.
- 5. Advise the President of the University and the Scientific Council on research integrity and research ethics.
- 6. Champion, in coordination with the Deanship of Research Oversight and Coordination, the training and the embedding of a culture of research integrity and good practice across all areas of the University.
- 7. Review and approve the University Annual Statement on Research Integrity.
- 8. Review and investigate cases of ethics and compliance violation referred by Deanship of Research oversight and Coordination, Academic Department, Scientific Council or individuals.
